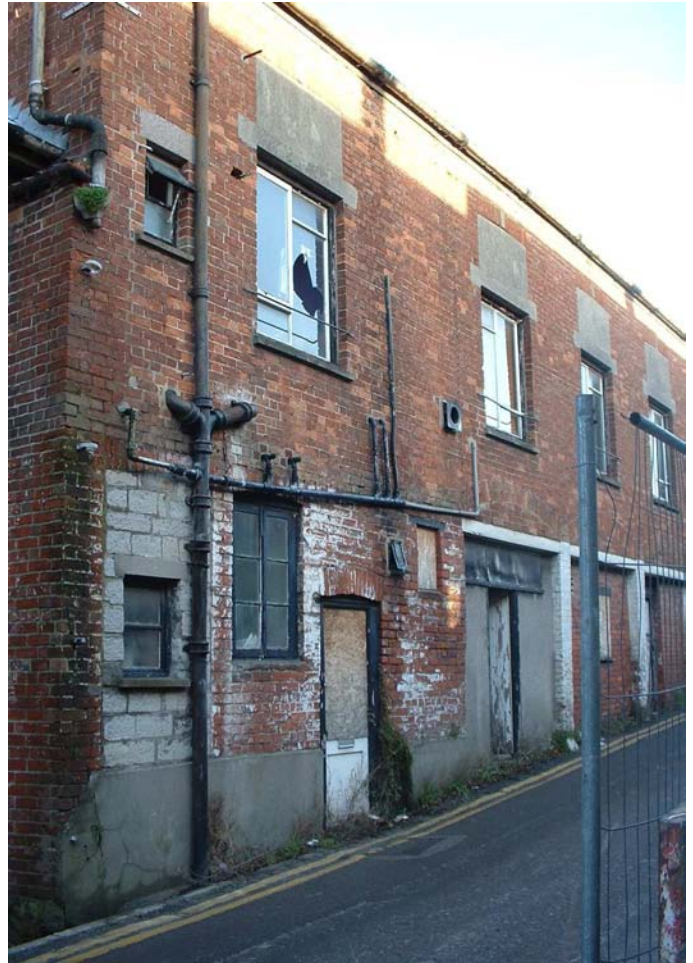


New Build Town Centre Residential Development The Pilgrim's Tap, Glastonbury
